## NASHUA SENIOR ACTIVITY CENTER MEMBERSHIP

**Membership Office Hours:** Monday through Friday: 9:15 am to 11:30 am

**Eligibility:** Membership is open to anyone in the greater Nashua area age 50 or older.

**Membership and Renewal Fees:** \$40 per year for individuals; \$60 per year for two individuals residing at the same address.

**Membership Renewal by Mail:** Include a *self-addressed stamped envelope* to have your membership card and receipt mailed to you; otherwise, pick up your card and receipt when you visit the Senior Center.

**Veterans Discount:** Eligible military service veterans receive a \$5 discount.

**Membership Fee Exemption:** Membership fee is waived for seniors 90 years and older.

**Payment:** Cash, personal checks, credit cards, and debit cards are accepted.
